NEW BUSINESS

Revision of Water Rules - Landlord Letter Authorizing Tenants to Use Water System - The proposed change to CC&Rs would require the Landlord to send a notarized letter authorizing tenants to use the water system in order to dissuade theft by squatters.

Tom Cumming moved to change the Water Rules to add Under Rule 5 Section 1 – Owners who wish to have their tenants pay the water bill will be responsible for transmitting to HSCA a notarized statement identifying the tenant and advising the tenant that the tenant will be transmitting an application for Water Connection and Service; and the owners will also be responsible for payment of outstanding charges left by tenants who have vacated the property. Caroline Weber seconded. After discussion, the motion passed with unanimous approval.

A sample letter will be created by administration.

<u>Emergency Fund Status and Determination of CAP amount</u> – After discussion, the Board agreed by general consent to wait for the cost estimates on several ongoing projects before making a decision.

<u>Set Date for Political Forum</u> – Saturday, July 30th was set for the political forum. All candidates will be invited.

<u>Road Paving Project Committee</u> – After discussion the following Committee Members volunteered: Roger Guenette, Steve Bailey, Joe Kovach and Lance Decker.
