REPORTS

Kathryn Kuhlman motioned to authorize the attorney to contact Dr. Hibashi to negotiate the easement. Tom Cumming seconded. Motion passed by by unanimous approval.

<u>Quarterly Financials</u> – Lance Decker reported. He noted that HSCA is currently 7% over budget due to several unexpected expenses such as the pool and the wellhead.

Board approach the County to ask them to withhold a building permit to lot owners until they fulfill any requirements by the DRC Committee. The Board agreed and noted that the package needs to be revised to give lot owners more user-friendly instructions. A workshop will be developed to consider these issues.

<u>Community Events and Activity Committee (CEAC)</u> – Caroline Weber reported. Results from the questionnaire sent to members indicated that a clear favorite was pickleball. The Board agreed to transform one of the tennis courts for this purpose.
