

MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS FOR USE PRIVILEGES OF HAWAIIAN SHORES COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION'S RECREATIONAL FACILITIES

1. ELIGIBILITY AND ADMISSION – Membership privileges for use of HSCA recreational facilities shall be limited to Hawaiian Shores Community Association Members in good standing (all fee assessments paid current).

All members applying for use privileges shall do so in writing through the association office.

Entry cards will be issued to each approved applicant (member) and residents of their immediate household (associate members). There will be a charge for replacement of lost or stolen entry cards.

2. LIMITATION, SUSPENSION AND/OR REVOCATION – Membership privileges for use of recreational facilities may be limited, suspended and/or revoked by the board of directors of HSCA for the following:

- A. failure to abide by the rules
- B. for destroying property
- C. for conduct that is detrimental to other members or their guests
- D. failure to be an HSCA member in good standing
- E. for any other offense that the board of directors may determine is not in the best interests of the other members

All members are responsible for their associate members and guests conduct.

Before limiting, suspending or revoking membership privileges of a member, they will be notified in writing at least 3 days prior to the date the board of directors will consider the complaint against them. This notice shall state the time and place where the complaint will be considered. The member may appear before the board of directors in person or may give a written statement in their defense to be considered by the board. The board of directors shall make its decision in Executive Session. The member will be notified of the determination in writing. The action of the board of directors will be final.

3. GUESTS – There will be a charge for each guest brought to the recreational facilities and this charge will be set forth in the operating rules as will the number of guests allowed. Special arrangements will be made with the association office for special occasions when more than the allowed number of guests is expected.

4. LIABILITY – The association member who applies for use privileges shall be responsible for their associate members and guests. The association and its employees, officers, directors, representatives, members and any other persons who are in any manner connected with the association will not be held responsible for any and all injuries and/or personal loses suffered during or as a result of members, associate members and guest's use of the recreational facilities of HSCA.

5. RULES AND REQUIREMENTS - The board of directors may from time to time adopt, amend and/or repeal rules and requirements governing among other things, use of the recreational facilities.

A true and correct copy of all rules and requirements will be provided to each applicant at the time of application. Any amendments thereafter shall be effective 5 days after the mailing to each member who has been approved to use the facilities.
